

Daniel Farber is the Sho Sato Professor of Law at the University of California, Berkeley. He is also the chair of the Energy and Resources Group, an interdisciplinary department at Berkeley. Professor Farber clerked for Judge Philip W. Tone of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 7th Circuit and for Justice John Paul Stevens of the U.S. Supreme Court. He taught at the University of Illinois and the University of Minnesota before moving to Berkeley in 2001. He is the author of twelve books and over a hundred law review articles. Professor Farber is a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and a member of the American Law Institute.
