

**Kathy Jacobs** is the Executive Director of the Arizona Water Institute, a consortium of the three Arizona universities focused on water-related research, education and technology transfer focused on water supply sustainability. Ms Jacobs is a professor in the University of Arizona Soil, Water and Environmental Science Department at the UA, and has more than twenty years of experience as a water manager for the state of Arizona, including 14 years as the director of the Tucson Active Management Area. Her research interests include groundwater management, water policy, connecting science and decision-making, stakeholder engagement, and use of climate change and climate variability information for water management applications. She has worked on climate change related projects since 1997, and wrote the water sector chapter for the US National Assessment of the Impacts of Climate Change. She has served on six National Academy panels, including several related to the federal climate change science program and climate change issues.
